Tuition Discount Policy

- Sibling discount: 15% off for second and third attendees from the same immediate family
- NAA student discount: 15% is applied as tuition credit for the coming Fall

Application Fee

- Application before May 31: \$30
- Application after May 31: \$60

International Fee

- A \$300 international fee applies to students requiring visitor visas

Cancellations & Refunds

- Cancellation of at least 48 hours prior to the first day of enrolled program:
 - Full refund of tuition, lunch, and boarding fee
 - \$20 processing fee
- Cancellation of less than 48 hours prior to the first day of enrolled program
 - 60% refund of tuition, lunch, and boarding fees
 - \$20 processing fee
- Cancellation on or after the first day of enrolled program
 - No refund

Program Changes

- Requests made 24 hours after the first day of enrolled program:
 - \$30 processing fee



2023 Summer Camp Policies

1. General Health

Physical Examination

- Timeframe: within 1 year (no earlier than June 27, 2022)
- **Documentation:** Examination form provided by the doctor's office OR [Standard NY School Health Examination Form](#)

Immunization

- **Required vaccinations::**
 - MMR: Required for all campers
 - COVID-19: recommended for sleepaway campers
- **Documentation:** Immunization records are required at time of enrollment

2. Use of Electronic Devices

- No phones on campus
- Students have access to phone and Skype in the dormitory, to be used under supervision of a dorm teacher
