Outdoor Adventure Camp – Activity Overview

By combining these activities, our outdoor adventure camp program can provide campers with a well-rounded experience that fosters physical fitness, outdoor knowledge, teamwork, and a deep appreciation for nature and adventure. View all offered courses below.

Note: Unless otherwise specified, camp activities cater to students of ages 10-17.

Activity	Description
Outdoor Sports and Games	Incorporate a variety of outdoor sports like soccer, basketball, and ultimate frisbee to promote physical fitness, teamwork, and friendly competition among campers.
Survival Skills	Teach campers essential survival skills, including fire making, shelter building, navigation, and wilderness first aid. These skills promote self-sufficiency and outdoor confidence.
Tennis and Golf	Offer tennis and golf lessons for campers interested in racket or club sports. These activities enhance hand-eye coordination, focus, and patience.
Field Games	Organize classic field games like capture the flag, kickball, and tug-of-war. These games encourage camaraderie, strategy, and outdoor fun.
Marksmanship and Archery	Provide instruction in marksmanship and archery, emphasizing safety, accuracy, and responsible handling of firearms and bows. Campers can practice target shooting and improve their aim.
Rock Climbing	Set up rock climbing walls or take campers on outdoor rock climbing adventures, teaching them climbing techniques, safety procedures, and the importance of trust and communication with belay partners.
Kayaking and Canoeing	Introduce campers to water sports by offering kayaking and canoeing lessons. Teach paddling techniques, water safety, and environmental stewardship.
Swimming and Water Activities	Utilize the camp's natural water resources for swimming and other water-based activities like snorkeling or paddleboarding. Promote water safety and aquatic fitness.
Adventure Excursions	Plan off-site adventure excursions such as hiking, camping, or white-water rafting trips to challenge campers' outdoor skills and build their confidence in various environments.



STEM Camp – Activity Overview

This STEM-focused summer camp program will cater to both younger and older students, offering a wide range of STEM activities that cover robotics, coding, math, strategy games, engineering, and physical fitness. Campers will have the opportunity to explore their interests and develop valuable skills in a fun and educational environment. View all offered courses below.

For Grades 5-8	Description
Robotics	Introduce campers to the exciting world of robotics, teaching them the basics of building and programming robots. They can work on fun and educational robotics projects that emphasize problem-solving and creativity.
JavaScript Programming	Provide introductory coding classes where campers can learn the fundamentals of JavaScript programming, creating interactive web-based projects and games.
Math Count	Challenge campers with math-focused activities that go beyond the regular curriculum. This can include math competitions, puzzles, and problem-solving exercises.
Chess	Teach campers the fundamentals of chess, fostering critical thinking, strategy, and sportsmanship through friendly matches and tournaments.
Go-Chess	Introduce campers to the ancient and strategic game of Go, promoting spatial reasoning, pattern recognition, and decision-making.
Snap Circuit Engineering	Offer hands-on electronics and engineering classes using Snap Circuits kits. Campers can build various electronic projects while learning about circuits and components.

3D Printing	Dive into the world of 3D printing, allowing campers to design and print their creations using 3D printers. This activity promotes creativity and technological literacy.
JavaScript Programming	Continue with more advanced JavaScript programming, focusing on web development, app creation, and interactive projects.
Python Programming	Introduce Python programming, a versatile and widely used language. Campers can work on software development, data analysis, and machine learning projects.
Math Olympiad	Challenge older campers with advanced math problems and competitions, preparing them for math olympiads and advanced mathematical thinking.
Chess	Continue to develop chess skills, with a focus on advanced strategies, tactics, and participation in competitive chess tournaments.

SAT Prep	Prepare high school students for the SAT exam with dedicated prep classes and practice tests to help them excel in college admissions.
Table Tennis and Badminton	Offer recreational and competitive options for table tennis and badminton, allowing campers to continue enjoying these sports.



Music Camp – Activity Overview

For both beginning and seasoned musicians, the 2-week intensive program will provide our campers with a more in-depth view on music and its intrinsic value. Northern Academy's music camp includes a wide variety of music courses that strives to give our campers the opportunity to learn and explore the musical world. View all offered courses below.

Activity	Description
Music Theater	Offers campers the chance to learn to perform by combining songs, acting and dancing. This course allows students to learn to communicate through words, actions, and movement.
Keyboard	This course is designed for keyboard players who want to take their performance skills to the next level. Prior playing experience required.
Instrumental Workshops	Offers a variety of instrumental workshops, including piano, guitar, flute, and more. These workshops can accommodate students of different skill levels allowing them to improve their technique and repertoire.
Music Theory and Ear Training	Music theory and ear training are essential foundations for musicians. This activity covers music theory, harmony, rhythm, and ear training to enhance campers' understanding of music.
Recording and Music Production	Introduces campers to the world of recording and music production. Teaches them how to use digital audio workstations (DAWs) and recording equipment, allowing them to produce and record their music.
Music History and Appreciation	Provides a historical perspective on music by offering classes in music history and appreciation. Explore various musical eras and genres, with listening sessions and discussions.
Ensemble and Chamber Music	Fosters collaboration and ensemble skills. Campers work together to rehearse and perform chamber music pieces, developing their ensemble playing abilities.
Music Creativity Thru Technology	Teaches campers about music technology and electronic music production. Campers experiment with synthesizers, electronic music software, and MIDI controllers to create electronic compositions.
Performance Opportunities (Grand Finale)	Offers performance opportunities, such as solos, chambers, and music theater. This encourages campers to showcase their progress and helps gain valuable experience performing in front of an audience.



Fine Arts Camp – Activity Overview

By integrating these activities into our fine arts summer camp program, we can offer campers a comprehensive and enriching artistic experience. They will have the opportunity to develop their skills in drawing, painting, sculpture, and digital art, while also exploring other creative outlets like Chinese calligraphy, video editing, handcrafting, and jewelry making. Activity	Description
Foundation Drawing	Begin the program with foundational drawing classes. Campers will learn essential drawing techniques, such as perspective, shading, and composition, to build a strong artistic foundation.
Outdoor Sketching	Take advantage of the natural surroundings by offering outdoor sketching sessions. Campers can capture landscapes, architecture, single objects, etc. in their sketches, enhancing their observational skills.
Sculpture	Provide beginner sculpting classes, allowing campers to explore three-dimensional art. Students will work with clay to learn the basic structural foundation, from simple form to a complex object.
Painting	Offer painting classes in various mediums, including soft pastels, watercolor, etc. Campers can experiment with different painting techniques and styles while expressing their technique and creativity.
Chinese Calligraphy & Painting	Introduce campers to the beauty of Chinese calligraphy and painting. They can learn brushwork techniques, characters, and traditional Chinese painting styles.

Tuition Discount Policy

- Early Bird Discount: 5% off tuition if registered before May 31, 2024
- Sibling discount: 5% off tuition. The sibling discount applies to the second child and any additional children from the same household.
- Loyalty discount: 10% is applied on tuition for past summer camp families
- Discounts are applied to the net tuition, and it excludes all fees and taxes.

Application Fee

- Non-refundable \$30 application fee

Cancellations & Refunds

- Cancellation of at least 14 days prior to the first day of enrolled program:
 - Full refund of tuition, lunch, and boarding fee
 - \$30 processing fee
- Cancellation of less than 14 days prior to the first day of enrolled program
 - No refund

Themed Camp Request Change

- Requests made before 72 hours prior to the first day of enrolled program:
 - no processing fee
- Requests made after 72 hours prior to the first day of enrolled program:
 - \$30 processing fee
- All requests are subjected to availability.



2024 Summer Camp Policies

1. General Health

Physical Examination

- **Timeframe:** within 1 year
- **Documentation:** Examination form provided by the doctor's office OR [Standard NY School Health Examination Form](#)

Immunization

- **Required vaccinations::**
 - MMR: 2 doses. Required for all campers
 - Polio: 4 doses. Required for all campers *(or 3 doses if the last dose was applied after 4 years old)*.
- **Documentation:** Immunization records are required when completing the Enrollment Form

2. Use of Electronic Devices

- No phones on campus
- Students have access to phone and Skype in the dormitory, to be used under supervision of a dorm teacher
