- Entrepreneurship Business Start Up Fee: \$750
 - This fee will cover the transportation to the events, material cost of product development, marketing promotion, etc.

- Rising Stars (Beginning and Intermediate level dancers)
 - Dance classes in the morning then mixed-themed activities in the afternoon
- Dance Elites (Advanced level dancers, by audition only)
 - 12:30pm-4pm
- Campers will be placed into the appropriate level based on skill level

2026 Summer Camp Tuition & Fee Policy

Tuition Due Dates

- Deposit: non-refundable \$200 deposit upon registration
- Remaining: Due before June 22, 2026
 - In order for your child to participate, the remainder of your tuition balance must be paid by June 23, 2026.
- If full payment is not received by June 22, 2026, then your child's registration will be cancelled without notice and refunds.

Tuition Discount Policy

- Early Bird Discount: 10% off tuition if full tuition is paid before April 1, 2026
- Loyalty discount: 10% is applied on tuition for all past summer camp families and current Northern families
- Sibling discount: 5% off tuition per child. The sibling discount applies to the second child and any additional children from the same household.
- Discounts are applied to the net tuition, and it excludes all fees and taxes.

Camp Enrollment Requirements

- Camp Enrollment Requirements:
 - Maximum 30 participants - Northern Explorer
 - Maximum 26 participants per level - Dance Stars
 - Minimum 5 participants, Maximum 20 participants - Smash Champs, Outdoor Adventure, Music Adventure, Arts & Crafts, SciBite—The Real Taste Of Science, Entrepreneurship
- Boarding Enrollment Requirement:
 - Maximum 25 male campers and 25 female campers

Cancellations and Refunds

- Deposits for all camps are refundable in the event of camp cancellation.
- Cancellation requests before June 22, 2026:
 - Deposit is non-refundable
 - If paid in full, then full refund of tuition, lunch, and boarding fee (if applicable) minus the \$200 non-refundable deposit
- Cancellation requests after June 22, 2026:
 - No refund

Camp or Class Request Change

- Requests made before 72 hours prior to the first day of enrolled program:
 - no processing fee
- Requests made after 72 hours prior to the first day of enrolled program:
 - \$50 processing fee
- Requests made after during summer camp:
 - \$50 processing fee
- All requests are subjected to availability.



2026 Summer Camp Policies

1. General Health

Immunization

- **Required vaccinations:**
 - MMR: 2 doses. Required for all campers
 - Polio: minimum 2 doses. Required for all campers (*or 3 doses if the last dose was applied after 4 years old*).
- **Documentation:** Immunization records are required when completing the Enrollment Form

Health Insurance

- All parents are *required* to send us their child's health insurance

2. Use of Electronic Devices

- No personal phones on campus
- Students have access to school phones
- Boarding campers also have access to Facetime and Skype in the dormitory, to be used under supervision of a dorm teacher

3. Northern Academy Policies

- Summer Camp Dress Code:
 - Pants: no graphics/ripped pants, minimum height right above the knees
 - Tops: no graphics, keep shoulders covered
 - Refrain from wearing short shorts, short skirts, and tops with straps (ie. tank tops).
- Wear closed toe covered shoes
